Your child recently took the *Stanford Achievement Test Series, Tenth Edition (Stanford 10)*. This booklet, *Understanding Test Results*, explains the test results shown on your child's score report. It also explains why children are tested and how you can help your child learn.

While you are looking at your child's score report, it is important to remember that *a student does not pass or fail the Stanford 10*. The results of the Stanford 10 are meant to be used by the school, and by parents, to help all children do their best in school.
